Montana State University-Northern NORTHNET Things you need to know and do to get started:

1. You need to know what courses are being offered via NorthNet.

You can find the courses offered via NorthNet in the MSU—Northern course schedule. This can be viewed by clicking [HERE](#). You can select and print the courses MSU-Northern will be offering during the semester. NorthNet courses will be listed as “NorthNet” under mode of delivery method and will be listed with the following section numbers: Havre (101), Great Falls (401), Lewistown (501), Poplar (734) and Wolf Point (746). These courses can also be accessed by following the “Get Course Schedule” link on our NorthNet page or at <http://www.msun.edu/stuaffairs/registrar/registra.htm>.

2. You need to understand that the experience of taking a course via NorthNet is not the same as that of taking a traditional face-to-face course.

Read and understand the documents “A Student’s Guide to Learning Via

NorthNet” and “Responsibilities & Procedures for Distance Learning” before you enroll in a NorthNet course.

3. You must register for the course with Montana State University-Northern.
