Van Safety Course

If you think you are going to need to drive a 15 passenger van in the next 9 months for classes, then it is required that you to have a current Van Safety Certificate or a CDL with a passenger endorsement. To get this certificate you need to pass a 3-hour course which will only be offered twice, once in January and once in February so please let Sharon Caven know if you will need the course and what time is best for you. They will do their best to fit the classes into a time slot that is most convenient. Students are not allowed to take a 15 passenger van unless they are an assistant coach or assistant advisor and will be with the coach or advisor. The athletic department's 15 passenger van is only to be used by the athletic department. The Van Safety Training is mainly directed to the Athletic Department but is open to any employee. Taking this training does not authorize anyone to use the athletic department's 15 passenger van.
