## Joseph Auditions

Casting auditions have been scheduled for the joint Montana Actor's Theatre/Havre High School musical production of Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat and the Montana Actor's Theatre production of Cupid & Psyche. Auditions for both productions will be held Friday, December 4th, at 7:00 o'clock p.m., and Saturday December 5th, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., in the Havre High School auditorium, with callbacks being held Saturday afternoon/evening.

Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat (music by Andrew Lloyd Webber, lyrics by Tim Rice), is a delightful and vibrant musical based on the biblical saga of Joseph and his coat of many colors, set to an engaging array of musical styles, from country-western and calypso to bubble-gum pop and rock'n'roll. Minimally, a cast of 17 men and 14 women with a children's chorus ages K-8 will be required to bring this award winning musical to life. This production will run from March 18th through 21, 2010, and will be directed by Casey Pratt.

Cupid & Psyche, by Joseph Fisher, is a comedy adapted from the Greek fairy-tale of Cupid and the mortal princess, Psyche, based on the story of what happens when the God of Love is sent by his mother to destroy the most beautiful woman in the world and instead falls in love with her. Directed by Audrey Barger this production requires casting four men and four women and will run January 29, 30, February 4th, 5th, and 6th, 11th, 12th, 13th, and 14th, 2010.

Any community member with an interest in theatre is welcome and encouraged to audition as roles have not been pre-cast and between the two productions there will be over 50 parts available. Participants may select to audition for either or both productions.

## Computer Corner

**Google Tips: Find it fast - Current time elsewhere, movie times, conversions**

Find the current time elsewhere:

Don't bother trying to convert the time from your local setting to a distant city. Just type **time city**, as in **time Beijing**, to see the current time in that location.

Find movie times:

On the Web you have a myriad of choices to look up show times, but Google's simplicity is tough to beat. Just type **movies zip code** (or city), as in **movies 59501**. Click the **More movies** link to get specific information about the movies and where they are showing.

Convert measurements, currency, metrics and more:

Google's powerful built-in converter calculator can help you out whether you're cooking dinner or traveling abroad. Find out how many teaspoons are in a quarter cup by entering **quarter cup to teaspoons**, or how many centimeters in foot - **centimeters in foot**, or how many Euros there are to five dollars - **5 USD to Euros**, or how many seconds there are in a year - **seconds in a year**.

So the basic format for anything you want to convert is: *{quantity} {current unit} to {convert to unit}* -or- *{quantity} {current unit} in {convert to unit}*
