Bio-Energy Center Works With HHS



The advanced biology class of Havre High School, under Mr. David Burleigh, spent four class periods of lecture and hands-on-experiments with the Bio-Energy Center staff of MSU-Northern to learn more about biodiesel. The Bio-Energy Center's Research Scientist Jon Soriano visited Havre High School to deliver a lecture and a pre-lab discussion. The students then spent two class periods at the Center's Fuel Chemistry Lab to synthesize and purify their own bio-diesel. Last week, the students were introduced to bio-diesel fuel qualities and fuel properties by performing several ASTM(American Society for Testing and Materials) tests at the Center.

"Remembering the Fab Four"

The Northern Showcase Concert Association welcome the Beatles tribute band "Imagine" to our community on Tuesday, February 15th at 7:30pm in the Havre High School Auditorium. Tickets are available for \$20.00 for adults, \$10.00 for students.

The four lads joined in 1993 and have performed over 900 shows across the United States, Australia, New Zealand, the Orient and Central America. Their shows include entertaining with the Beach Boys, Jay Leno, The Temptations, Chicago, Badfinger, America, the Mandrells, the Shirelles, and the Buckinghams. They performed on national TV for the Nokia Sugar Bowl half-time show- an outdoor concert for 30,000 in Virginia, and they were the first act to perform at the 20,000 seat USANA Amphitheater in Salt Lake City. Recently, the band entertained audiences touring 25 U.S. cities from California to Virginia, and last May they played in Shanghai China for over 75,000 screaming Beatles' fans. Yes, Beatlemania is alive and well on mainland China.

Word Tip

Add line numbers to a Word document

It isn't often that we need to number lines in a Word document, but the need does arise occasionally. In Word 2007/2010 easily enable the feature as follows:

- 1. Click the Page Layout tab.
- 2. In the Page Setup group, click Line Numbers.
- 3. Select the option that fits your application: Continuous, Restart each page or Restart each section.

If you want to remove numbering on a particular paragraph, you can highlight that paragraph and select the Suppress for current paragraph option.

To enable line numbering in word 2003:

- 1. From the File menu, choose Page Setup.
- 2. Click the Layout tab.
- 3. Click Line Numbering (at the bottom).
- 4. Check the Add Line Numbering option.
- 5. Check the appropriate options.
