- 1. Proposals:
 - 12-16 Survey of Natural Science NSCI 110/111

 - Science dept. is trying to remove all labs from lectures and making them separate to make it more equal for transfer and continuing students.

- 2. Gen. Ed. Committee has been asked to cut back on some General Education classes.

 - Spike recommends that we ask the faculty to review and determine what majority of classes are used by ranking them.

- 3. . Self~ Reporting
 - Proposal 11~39.
 - Academics Senate has tabled this proposal because they want feedback from faculty.
 - Stacey recommends doing an open showing of the Self-Reporting program with Jay Howland discussing the programs and showing how to use it.

- Fine Arts/ Humanities: Proposal 11~27 was approved by Academic Senate, but was denied by the Provost.
 - Provost felt was unfair to our transfer students and felt that proof was need before she could pass the proposal.
 - Christine Shearer-Cremean Dean of the College of Education, Arts, Science and Nursing will sample random transcript of 20 transfer students. This will be to see if student transfer with classes in one or both area of Fine Arts/ Humanities.
