Hill County Electric (HCE) offers a \$500 scholarship annually for a student entering the MSU-Northern Electrical Technology Program who is planning to work in Montana after certification. The \$500 scholarship is payable upon successful completion of the first semester of school and verification of the student maintaining a 2.0 or higher grade report average during that term. Completed applications are due in the HCE office on March 1st. HCE may interview the scholarship finalists before the final selection is made. Successful applicants will be notified by May 1st.

The HCE selection committee will select scholarship recipients based on the following:

- Employment History
- Personal Statement
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- High School and/or College Transcripts
- Scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who the judges consider to be the most likely to complete the apprenticeship and work as an electrician in Montana.
